Scope of Works

In the heart of London's Soho district, the Restore London team cleaned, repaired and restored the beautiful Grade II listed Oxford Street façade dating back to 1885, in addition we revamped the latterly constructed facades.

This iconic redevelopment which involved a multi-million pound “cut & Carve” refurbishment of the mixed-use office block saw our specialist works involve various elements of new stonework including the take down and rebuilding of traditional stone arches, extensive traditional cleaning of the facades was also carried out. The scheme also involved demolishing the top floor of the building, carrying out structural alterations to the remaining structure, installing a new three storey structural steel frame. Our role was to match in all new stone and brick repairs – seamlessly, which was more than achieved.
